

## Second Sunday of Lent

### From The Pastor

The transfiguration of Christ is something completely unique, in scripture we see others go up a mountain to be close to God, in fact the two others that appear before the apostles Moses and Elijah are great examples. Moses to talk to God and bring back the ten commandments, and Elijah's mountain top teaches us to look for God's voice in the small and insignificant, not the boomy thunder and storm. In the examples of Moses and Elijah we see them changed, in the transfiguration, Christ does not change, the scales rather fall from the eyes of humanity and the reality of His Divinity is at last revealed.

Christ had just told His closest disciples that crucifixion was awaiting Him in Jerusalem, that this is Christ's goal, to offer Himself as sacrifice for each of us. One could very clearly understand shock and despair on the minds and hearts of the apostles. To give his disciples strength and support to go through the passion of Christ and not lose hope, Christ gave the apostles this moment.

As we continue our Lenten journey the question becomes, do we recognize the moments when Christ removes the scales from our own minds and hearts in order to allow hope to endure. As we offer prayers, fasting and alms giving this lent, let it be our hope that we offer to others.

### ***Whatever you do, don't throw them away!***

According to the *Code of Canon Law*, **blessed items are not to be discarded in a trash can**, but treated with respect (cf. #1171). At Mass these palm branches are set apart by a blessing making them "sacramental," an object that is meant to draw us closer to the celebration of the seven sacraments. Throwing them in the trash ignores their sacred purpose and treats them like any other object we no longer need.

Most sacramentals, like palm branches for example, can be burned or buried in order to properly dispose of them. This type of disposal honors their sacred purpose and returns them to the earth in a dignified way. Anyone can do this.



#### If These Walls Could Talk...

What is the oldest artifact in our church? Would you believe it is from the time of Jesus Christ? Look at the statue of Saint Andrew to the right of the altar. At the foot of the statue is a reliquary which holds a First Class relic of Saint Andrew the Apostle. A First-Class Relic is defined as the body or a portion of the body of a Saint, for example: bone, ashes, flesh, or hair. These are considered so precious that they are rarely entrusted to individuals but are placed in Faith Communities.

Tradition tells us that Saint Helena, Constantine's mother,

discerned which of the three crosses that were found on the hill of Calvary was the True Cross, upon which our Savior died for us, by placing a sick child on them. The child was restored to health when he made contact with the True Cross. The Church's official prayers on various feast days bear witness to the miracles performed through relics.

Christ is God who became present, in the flesh, when He came into the world. The flesh has a significant role in life. The relics of saints give witness to holiness that was embodied in the flesh. They give us hope that even in our lives, with all the temptations that come through the experiences of the flesh, we are called to be saints as well. The body will be reunited with the soul at the end of time. The body is the vessel for the soul and as such it is respected and honored. The saints show us how to live through the physical world while rising above it. They also teach us how to die. When we venerate relics, we are truly venerating holiness – the rising of the soul toward godliness.

The Chapel of St. Anthony in Pittsburgh, PA is home to the largest collection of relics in the world, outside of the Vatican.



